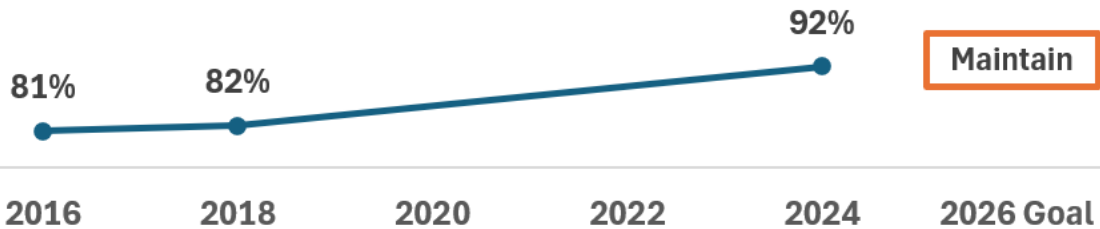


## Goal 1: Environment

Protect and, when appropriate, enhance the natural environment and address climate change through development of citywide policies, initiatives, and actions that ensure a sustainable future.

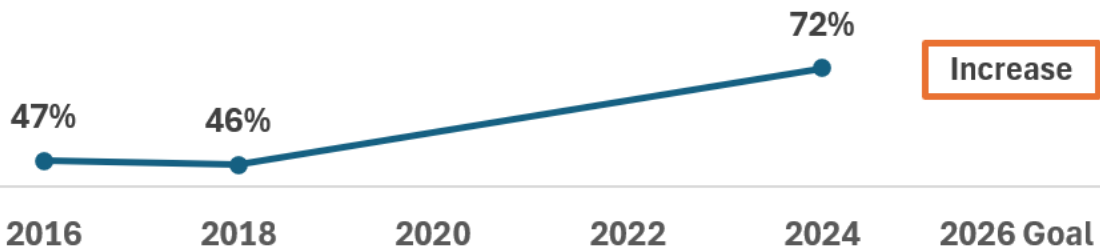
### Overall quality of the natural environment

(% of residents who rated good or excellent)



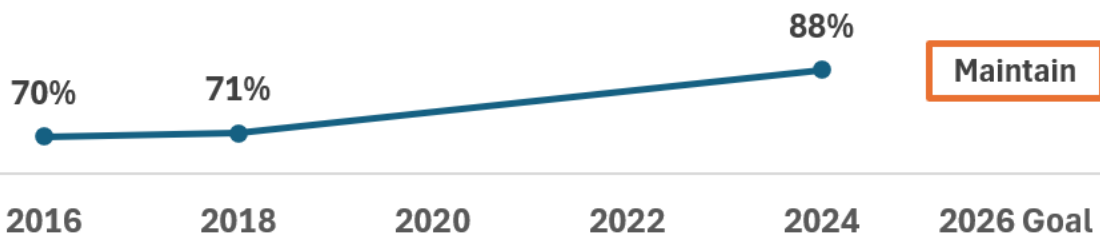
### Quality of preservation of natural areas

(% of residents who rated good or excellent)



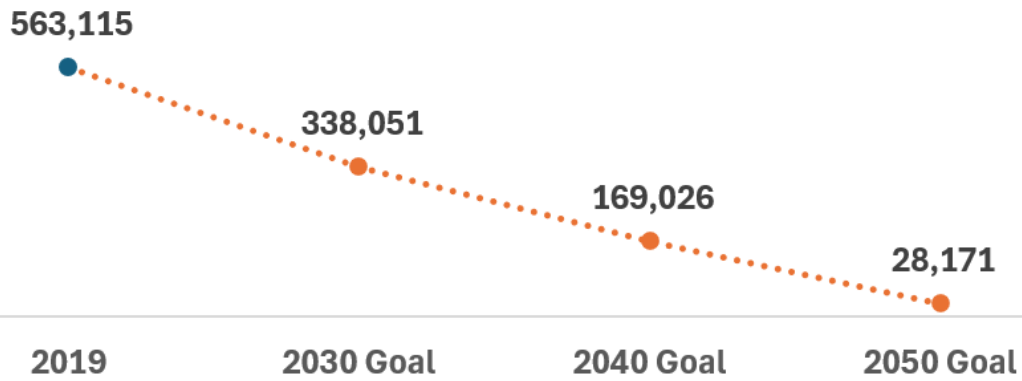
### Availability of paths and walking trails

(% of residents who rated good or excellent)



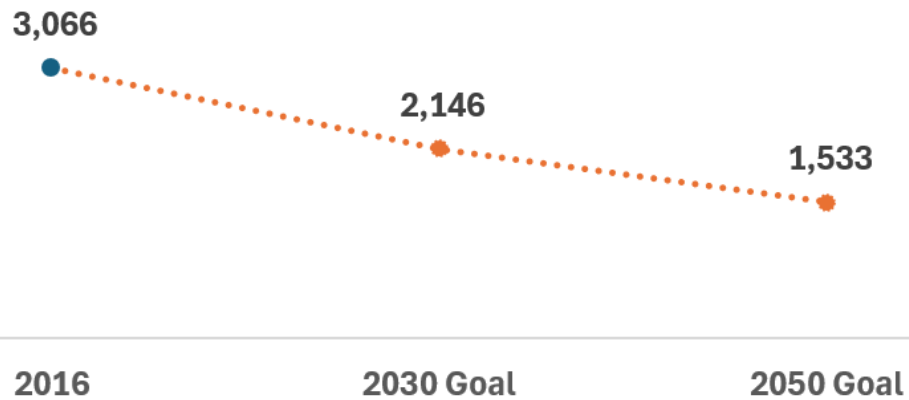
### Greenhouse Gas Emissions

Ensure City government is transparent and builds trust with its diverse community by engaging residents in the decision-making process and promoting understanding of the City's activities through education and clear communication.

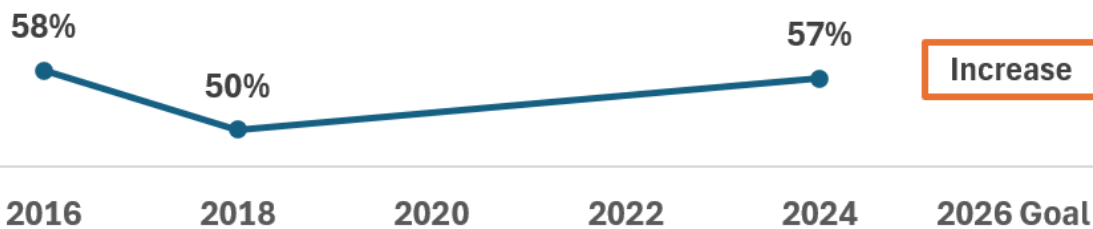
### The job Sammamish does at welcoming resident involvement

(% of residents who rated good or excellent)



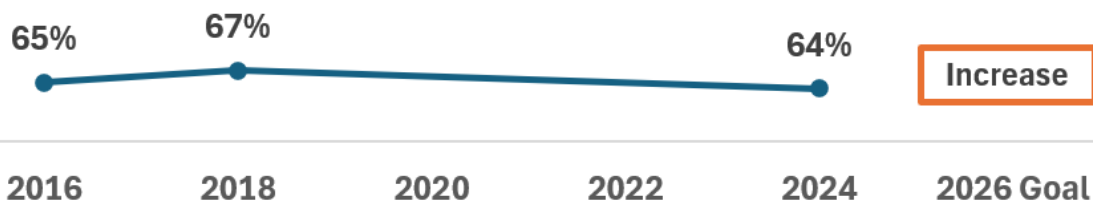
### Overall confidence in Sammamish government

(% rated good or excellent)

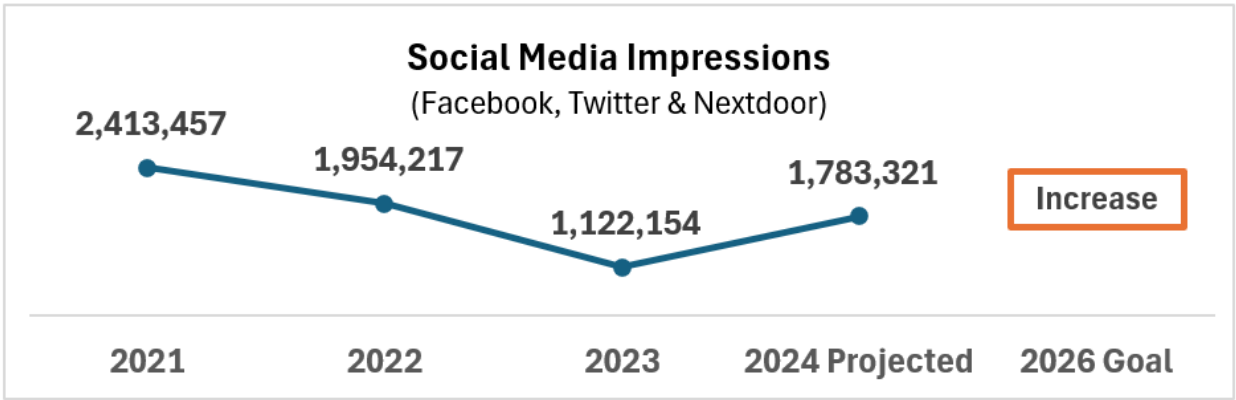

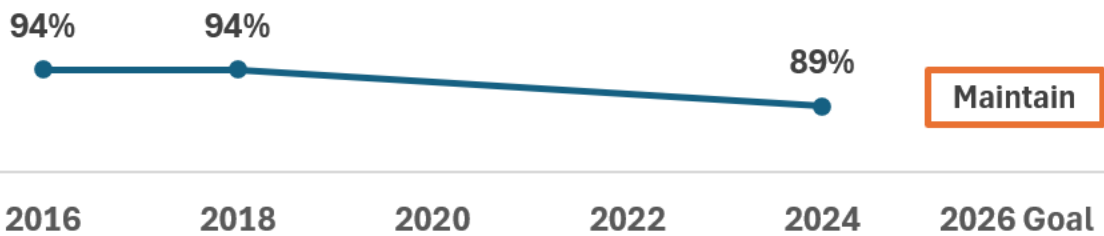

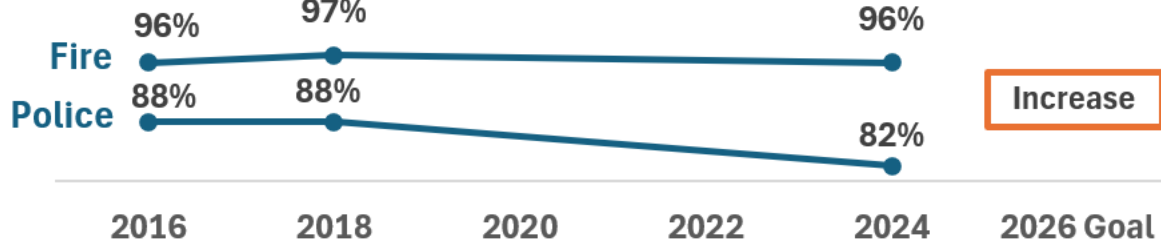
#### Overall feeling of safety

(% of residents who rated good or excellent)



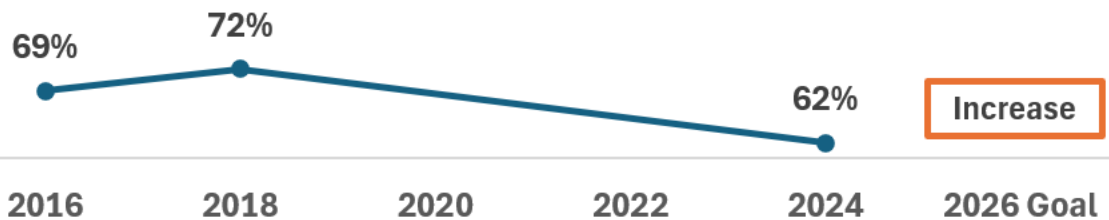
#### Police & Fire Services

(% of residents who rated good or excellent)



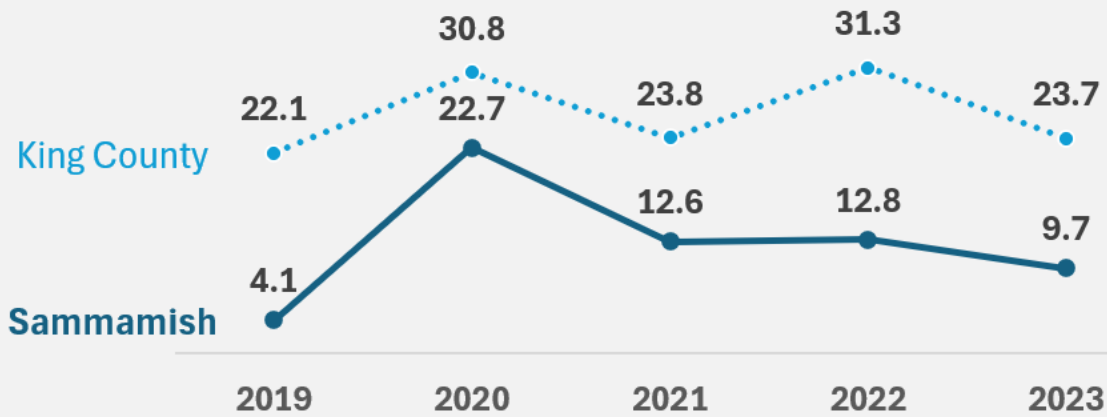
#### Emergency Preparedness

(% of residents who rated good or excellent)



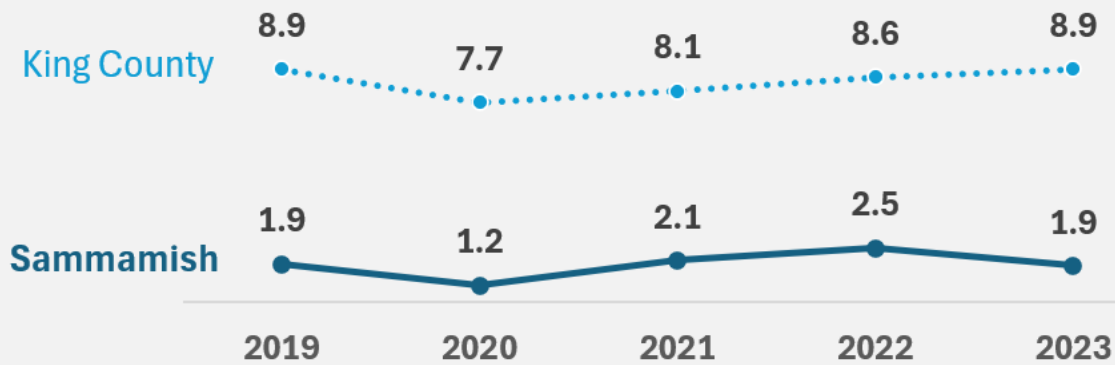
### Crimes Against Property

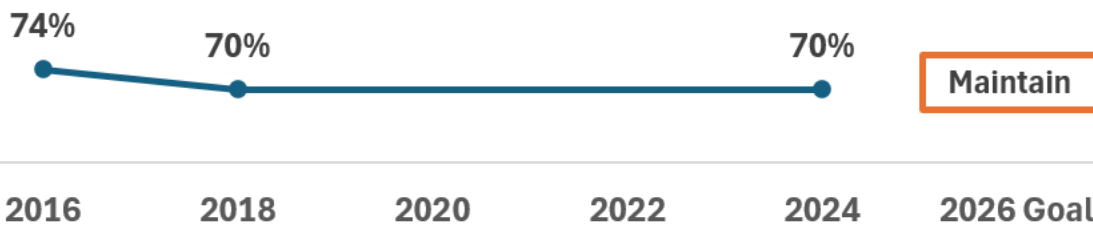

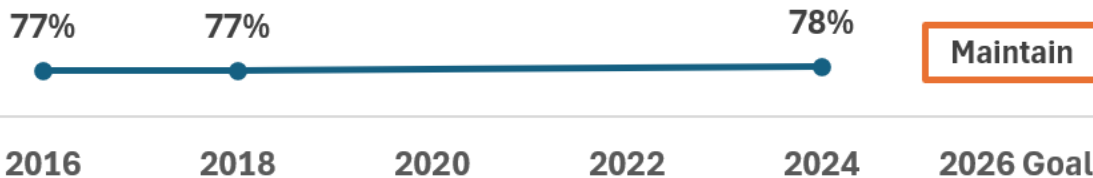
### Treating all residents fairly

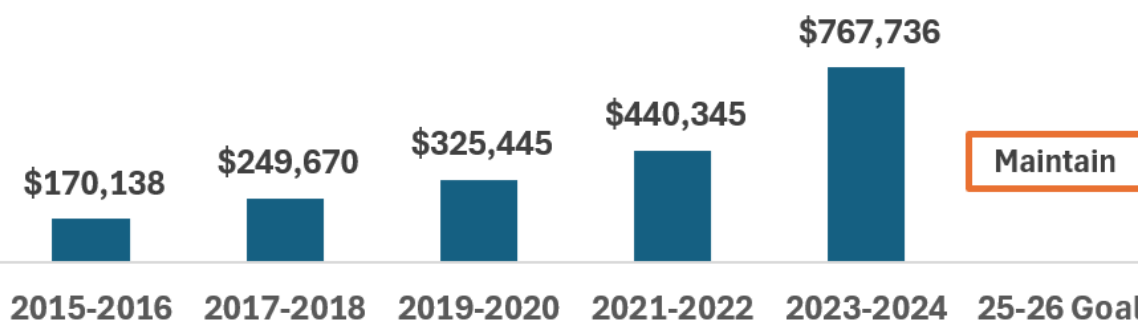

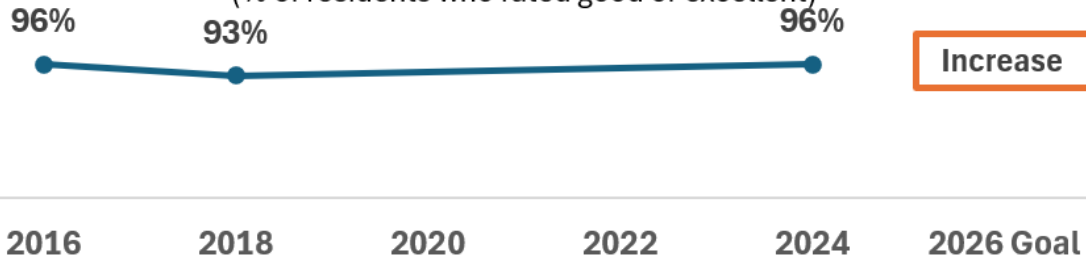

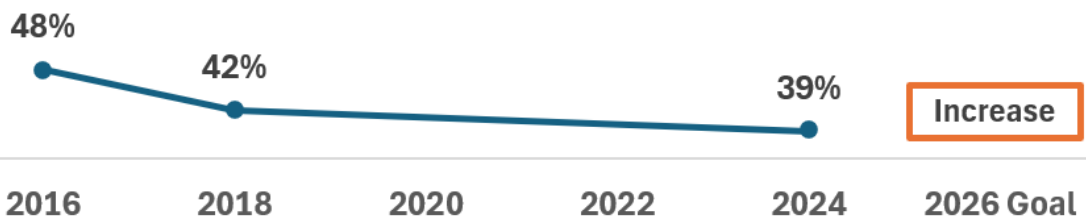
### Rating of your neighborhood as a place to live

(% of residents who rated good or excellent)



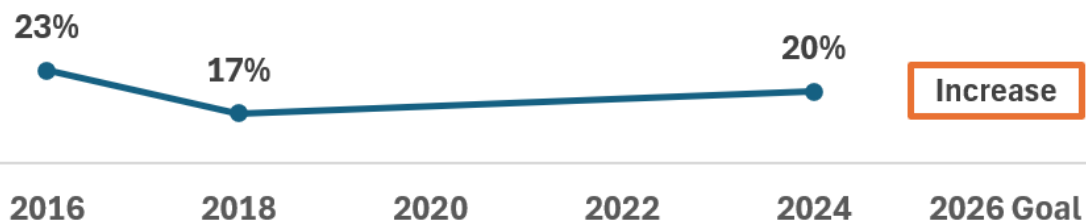
### Rating of the variety of housing options

(% of residents who rated good or excellent)

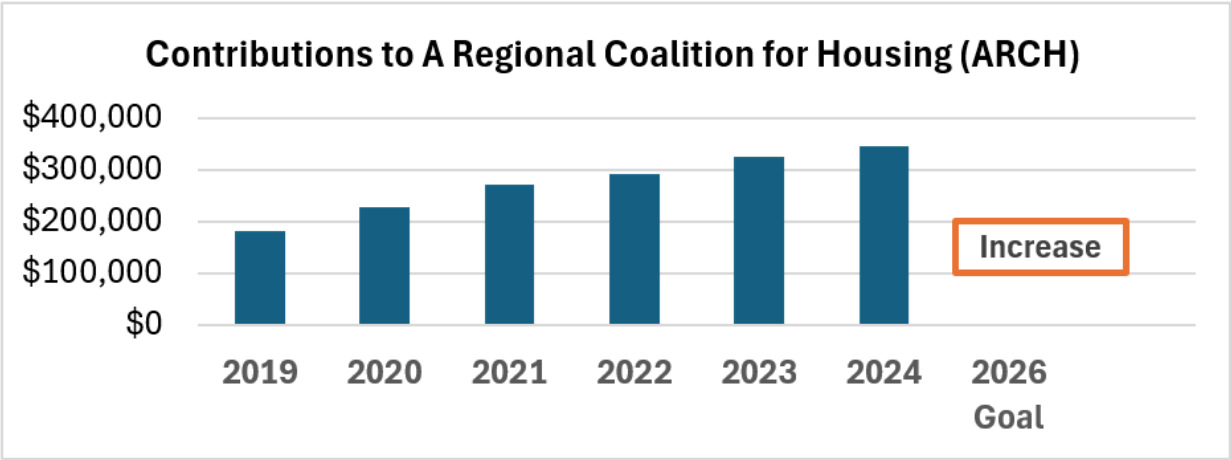


### Availability of affordable quality housing

**50%** of survey respondents strongly or somewhat support the City focusing on diverse and affordable housing options in Sammamish



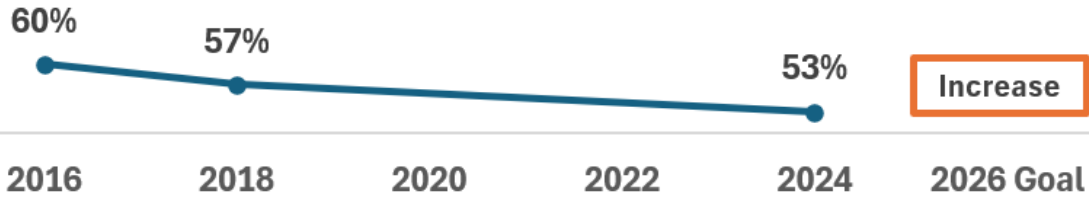

Ensure long term financial sustainability through efficient and effective government services funded by diverse and reliable revenue sources.

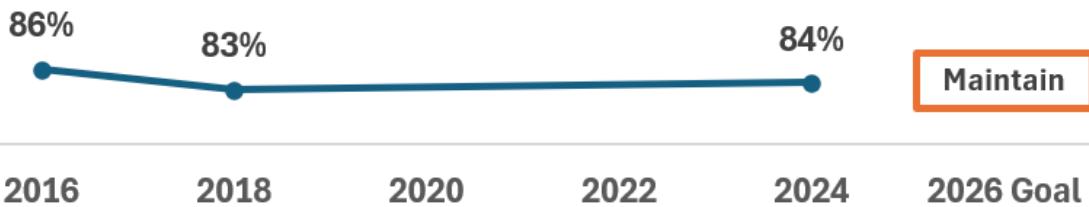
### Value of services for the taxes paid to Sammamish

(% of residents who rated good or excellent)

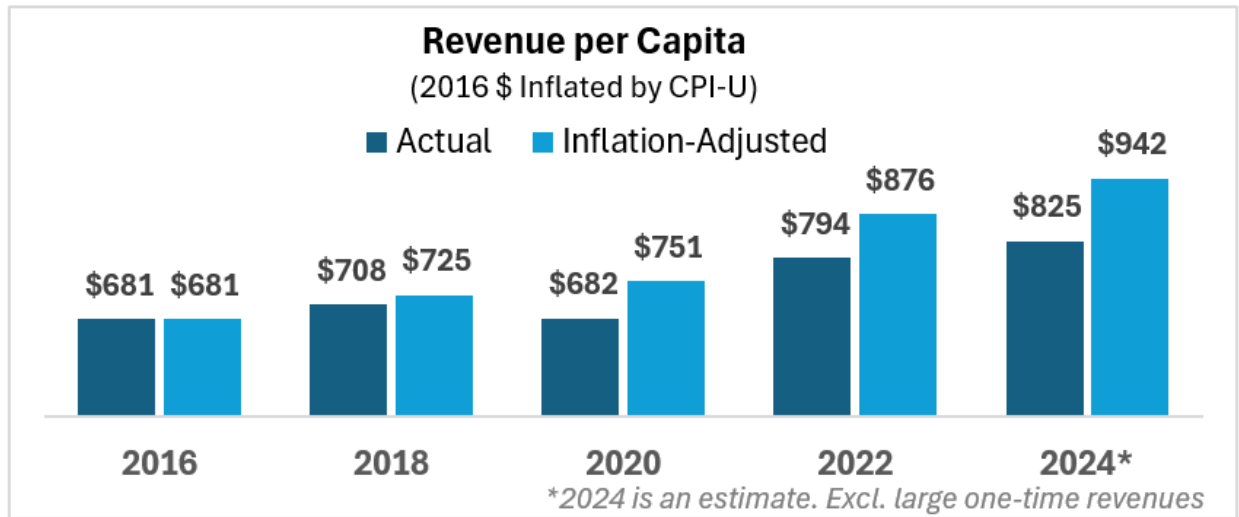


The 2024 Community Survey asked residents to rate how important it was for the City to focus on the following in the coming two years:

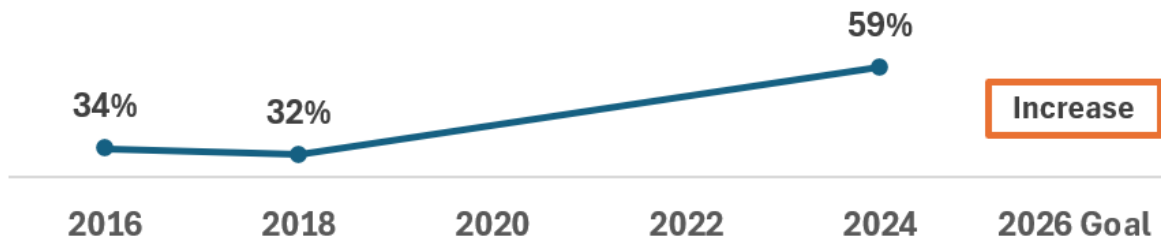

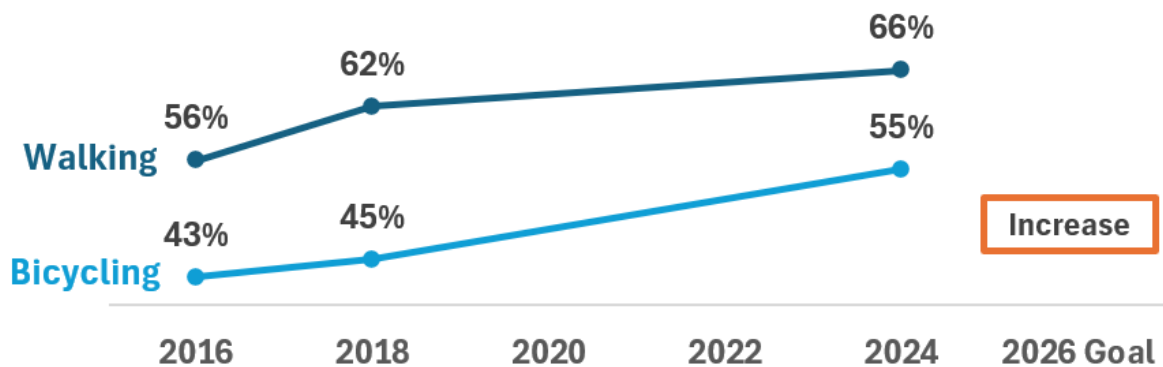
### Traffic Flow on Major Streets

(% of residents who rated good or excellent)



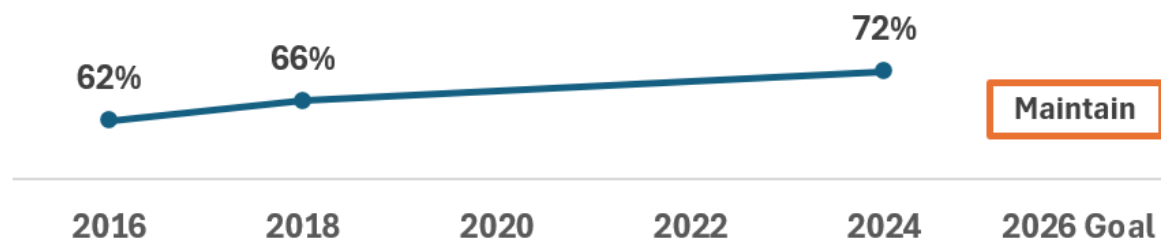
### Ease of travel by walking and bicycling

### Street Repair

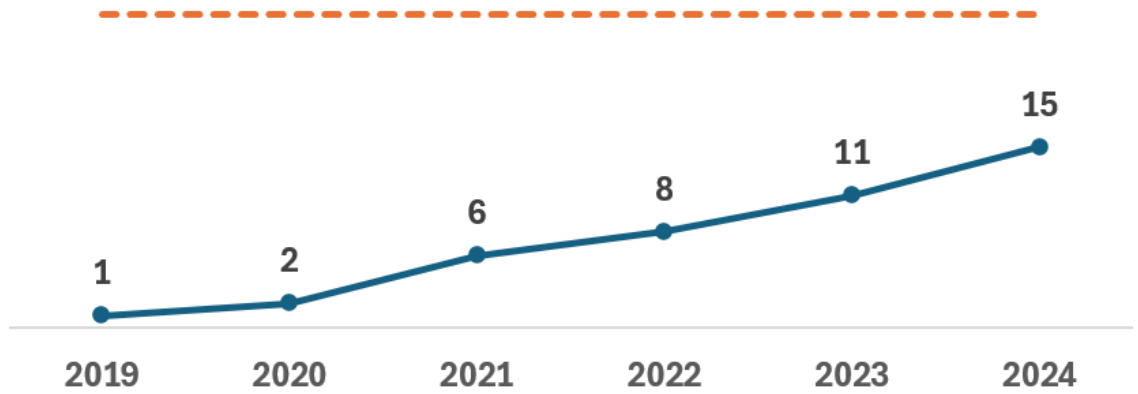
